**OBJECTIVES:** To share results of an ongoing capitalization and action-research work on the needs, challenges and potential solutions for transforming agricultural extension and advisory services (EAS) to better support agroecological transitions in West Africa. A policy brief on the levers to develop EAS for agroecology will be presented and discussed.

**PARTICIPANTS:** About forty participants are expected to attend in person and more than a hundred online. The working language will be French, but simultaneous translation into English will be provided online. The following types of actors are expected: policy makers (ECOWAS/PAE, MEAE, FAO...), donors (AFD, EU, GIZ, Swiss Cooperation, IFAD, etc.), farmers' organizations, NGOs, research institutions, networks (GFRAS, RESCAR-AOC).
